CZASY PRESENT/FUTURE		I. Strona czynna- the Active Voice	CZASY PAST/ FUTURE IN THE PAST
<b>Present Simple</b> S+V <sub>1</sub> [ <i>V<sub>(es)</sub></i> ( <i>he, she, it</i> )]  <b>Present Continuous</b> S+am/is/are+V <sub>ing</sub>  <b>Present Perfect</b> S+have/has+V <sub>3</sub>  <b>Present Perfect Continuous</b> S+have/has+ been+Ving	You watch TV every day. <u>Do</u> you watch TV every day? <b>Future</b> S+will+V <sub>1</sub>  <b>Future Continuous</b> S+will+be+Ving  <b>Future Perfect</b> S+will+have+V <sub>3</sub>  <b>Future Perfect Continuous</b> S+will+have+been+Ving	You will watch TV tomorrow. Will you watch TV tomorrow? You won't watch TV tomorrow. You will be watching TV at 5 tomorrow. Will you be watching TV at 5 tomorrow? You won't be watching TV at 5 tomorrow. You will have watched TV by 5 o'clock. Will you have watched TV by 5 o'clock? You won't have watched TV by 5 o'clock. You will have been watching TV for 24 hours tomorrow. II. Strona bierna - the Passive voice - S + BE + V <sub>3</sub>			
<b>Present Simple</b> S+am/is/are+V <sub>3</sub> <b>Present Continuous</b> S+was/were+ <u>being</u> +V <sub>3</sub> <b>Present Perfect</b> S+have/has+ <u>been</u> +V <sub>3</sub>	TV is watched. Is TV watched? TV isn't watched. TV is being watched. Is TV being watched? TV isn't being watched. TV has been watched. Has TV been watched?	TV was watched. Was TV watched? TV wasn't watched. TV was being watched. Was TV being watched? TV wasn't being watched. TV had been watched. Had TV been watched?	<b>Past Simple</b> S+was/were+V <sub>3</sub> <b>Past Continuous</b> S+was/were+ <u>being</u> +V <sub>3</sub> <b>Past Perfect</b> S+had+ <u>been</u> +V <sub>3</sub>
<b>Future Simple</b> S+will+be+V <sub>3</sub> <b>Future Perfect</b> S+will+have+been+V <sub>3</sub>	TV will be watched. Will TV be watched? TV will have been watched. Will TV have been watched?	TV would be watched. Would be TV watched? TV would have been watched. Would TV have been watched?	<b>Future in the Past</b> S+would+be+V <sub>3</sub> <b>Future Perfect in the Past</b> S+would+have+been+V <sub>3</sub>

**UWAGA!** Czasy *Future Perfect Continuous* (TV will have been being watched), *Future Continuous* (TV will be being watched) *Present Perfect Continuous* (TV has been being watched) *Past Perfect Continuous* (TV had been being watched) *Future Continuous in the Past* (TV would be being watched) i *Future Perfect Continuous in the Past* (TV would have been being watched) teoretycznie mogą tworzyć stronę bierną lecz w praktyce ich nie używamy zastępując czasami prostszymi np. *Future Perfect Continuous* w stronie biernej zastępuje *Future Perfect*, *Past Perfect Continuous* zastępuje *Past Perfect*.
